The present contempt petition has been filed pleading that there is wilful disobedience of the order dated 5.12.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 30729 of 2018. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“We, therefore, without commenting on the merits of the case, deem it appropriate to dispose of the present petition with a direction to the respondents to look into the grievance of the petitioners made in the representation Annexure P-2 and take a decision thereon by passing a speaking order as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. Ordered accordingly.”

As per order dated 5.12.2018, the respondent had to take a decision on the representation of the petitioners within a period of three

months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

As per the pleadings, copy of the order was sent through speed post on 22.5.2019. It is alleged that earlier representation was made for which no receipt was given.

Though the time period has already elapsed, at this stage still another opportunity is provided to the respondent to do the needful within three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case of failure, the petitioners would be at liberty to revive the contempt petition and the revival would be at the cost and responsibility of the respondent.

With the aforesaid observation, the contempt petition stands disposed of.
