Petitioner is seeking setting aside of the order dated 06.04.2017 (Annexure P-1), whereby his claim for grant of pay band of Rs.15600-39100+7600 Grade Pay from the date of joining with all consequential benefits at par with other law officers serving at DCRUST, Murthal and CCSHAU, Hisar, has been dismissed.

Learned counsel for respondent No.3-University has informed that the Vice Chancellor, after going through the order dated 06.05.2019, has taken a decision that the University has no objection to amend the rules for making the post of Law Officer with 10 years experience, with higher pay scale in accordance with law after adopting due procedure.

Keeping in view the said decision, the matter will be examined

by the Executive Council in due course.

In view of the said fact, this petition is disposed of by giving direction to respondent No.3-University to take a final decision on revision of the pay scales of Law Officers with 10 years' experience, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
