Reply by way of an affidavit of Superintendent, Central Jail, Gurdaspur on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4 has been filed in the Court today and same is taken on record.

As per the affidavit filed by learned State counsel, during the hearing of the case before the trial Court on 28.03.2019, the petitioner was produced in the Court and his remaining co-accused, who are in custody, were produced through video conferencing link. Statement of the petitioner under Section 313 Cr.P.C. was recorded on 28.03.2019. As per the *zimni* order dated 28.03.2019, the petitioner also filed an application for permitting him to sign the affidavits required for his business. The application was allowed and the case was adjourned to 04.04.2019, for recording the statement of accused Amit Doda under Section 313 Cr.P.C. The trial is at the fag end.

In this view of the matter, the present petition has become infructuous.

However, the petitioner would not be further transferred to another Jail during the pendency of the trial. Trial Court is directed to conclude the trial expeditiously.

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
