GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J (ORAL)

1. The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.22 dated 30.01.2019 under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC, Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties
2. Vide order dated 10.07.2019, the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get the statements recorded with regard to the genuineness of the compromise.
3. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Jalandhar has been received wherein it has been reported that statements of petitioner No.1, Vipin Kumar-Attorney of Yogesh Kumar (petitioner No.2) as well as of the complainant-Ramandeep Kaur have been recorded who have stated that they have compromised the matter and that complainant has no

objection if the FIR is quashed. It has specifically been opined by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Jalandhar that the compromise effected between the complainant and accused is genuine, without any pressure or coercion.

4. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.22 dated 30.01.2019 under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC, Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
