Petitioners seek a mandamus for direction official respondents No.1 to 3 to conduct a fair and impartial inquiry pursuant to a representation at Annexure P-8 having been submitted containing allegations against respondent No.4 who is a serving police official.

Writ petition raises a questions of fact. This Court in exercise of its power under Article 226 of the Constitution of India would not embark upon a roving inquiry in the matter. As such, while declining to interfere in the matter, liberty is granted to the petitioners to avail of their alternate remedy in accordance with law.
