Learned counsel for the petitioners states that reply on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 has not been filed so far.

Learned counsel for respondents No. 1 to 3 states that reply of respondents No. 1 to 3 is not necessary as the claim, which is being made by the petitioner, is against respondent No.4 who has already filed the reply.

Learned counsel for respondent No.4 states that keeping in view the directions given by this Court, a speaking order was passed by the respondents on 31.08.2017 rejecting the claim and the said order is not under challenge in the present writ petition and therefore, no relief can be granted.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that reply filed on behalf of respondent No.4 has not been supplied to her. Another copy of the reply has been supplied to counsel for the petitioners in the Court today.

Keeping in view the objection raised on behalf of respondents No.4 that the order rejecting the claim of the petitioners is not under challenge in the present writ petition, learned counsel for the petitioners states that she be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to challenge the order dated 31.08.2017 rejecting the claim of the petitioner.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
