Reply dated 30.10.2019 by way of affidavit of Dr. Gurdarshan Singh Brar, Assistant Director (Services), O/o Director, Public Instructions (Colleges), Punjab filed in Court is taken on record, copy handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State submits that order dated 23.10.2019 has been passed whereby the petitioner has been promoted as DPI (Colleges) w.e.f. 2.2.2006.
