1. Petitioner herein seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider and grant him the benefit of Dynamic ACP in terms of Government instructions dated 17.04.2000 (Annexure P-3) read with instructions dated 22.12.2011 (Annexure P-4) along with all consequential benefits arising therefrom.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if the instant writ petition is to be treated as representation and the same is disposed of with a direction to take a final decision thereupon within a stipulated time frame.

3. Submission made by counsel is found to be just and reasonable.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by the respondents as no further

proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to treat the writ petition as a representation of the petitioner and pass a speaking order in the light of Annexures P-20 and P-21, in accordance with law.

6. Let the needful be done within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

7. Disposed of in above terms.
