Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.100 dated 22.03.2019, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 326 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (*for short 'IPC'*), registered at Police Station Naraingarh, Tehsil Naraingarh, District Ambala.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 10.07.2019, passed the following order:-

“ Contends that neither the petitioner is named in the FIR; nor any injury has been attributed to him.

Notice of motion for 24.07.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail in the present case till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Contends that in terms of above order, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from S.I. Gurmukh Singh, has acknowledged that in terms of order dated 10.07.2019, petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, interim order dated 10.07.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

It is also made clear that petitioner shall fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when called for further investigation.

Disposed off accordingly.
