Petitioner herein seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the impugned order dated 24.04.2017 (Annexure P-6) whereby his claim for appointment as 'Constable' in Punjab Police was rejected. Even though he secured 28 marks in merit but in the impugned order, it is mentioned as 26 marks.

2. In the premise, petitioner submitted a representation dated 15.10.2017 (Annexure P-7) followed by legal notice dated 30.08.2018 (Annexure P-8) but the same were not adverted by the respondents. Hence, the writ petition.

3. Given the nature of order being passed, no notice is required to be issued, as there is no necessity to seek return by the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

4. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to

objectively consider the legal notice dated 30.08.2018 (Annexure P-8) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

- 5. Let the needful be done within a period of 45 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
