The contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 24.01.2019 passed by this Court in CWP No.2034 of 2019.

Reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Charanjit Singh, Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Ferozepur City filed today in the Court, is taken on record. Copy handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of reply, learned counsel for the petitioner

states that no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition. However, he raises grievance that interest has wrongly been calculated. He seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law to challenge the calculation.

The contempt petition is disposed of with liberty as prayed for.

It is clarified that in case a representation is moved by the petitioner with regard to calculation of interest, the respondents shall consider the same expeditiously.
