As regards the petitioners in both the petitions (Joginder Pal and Deepak Kapoor), they are stated to be the father-in-law and brother-in-law of the deceased, respectively.

They having been admitted to interim anticipatory bail vide an order passed by this Court on 10.07.2019 and 05.09.2019, respectively, learned State counsel on instructions from the police official present in Court to assist him, submits that the petitioners have joined investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required presently.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual

merits of the case for or against the petitioners, the aforesaid orders admitting them to interim bail are made absolute. The complainant will be at liberty to avail of her remedy if she is aggrieved in any manner with regard to investigation being conducted etc.

The petitions are disposed of accordingly.
