Grievance of the petitioner is that his candidature for re-employment to the post of Home Guard is not being considered without assigning any reason, whereas similarly situated Ex-Home Guards have been allowed to join. In the premise, the petitioner also submitted a representations dated 05.07.2017 (Annexures P-1 and P-2) which has not been adverted to, compelling the petitioner to cause issuance of legal notice dated 01.07.2018 (Annexure P-4) but to no avail. Hence this petition.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On advance service of copy of the petition, Ms. Anu Chatrath, Senior Advocate assisted by Ms. Ambika Bedi, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the Legal Notice dated 01.07.2018 (Annexure P-4) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

6. Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

7. Disposed of in above terms.
