In the present writ petition, the disputed question of facts arise, as to whether, the petitioner had submitted an option within a period of three months of the issuance of letter dated 20.07.2011 (Annexure P-3).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner had submitted the said option, which is being denied by the respondents that no option was received from the petitioner within the time frame as envisaged in letter dated 20.07.2011 (Annexue P-3).

Keeping in view these disputed question of facts, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to approach the appropriate authority for the redressal of his grievance.
