Petitioner-Ajay Kumar has prayed for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.118 dated 21.06.2015 under Section 22 Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 Act registered at Police Station Goraya, District Jalandhar.

On 10.07.2019, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that although he has been regularly appearing in the proceedings of trial Court even-since the year 2015, but on account of his absence on 30th May, 2019 his bail has been cancelled which was first instance of his default.

Notice of motion for 21st October, 2019.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the learned trial Court within a week from today and the trial Court shall release him on interim bail on

his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds subject to its satisfaction.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner produced the copy of the order dated 05.08.2019 passed by trial Court to contend that in compliance of the order dated 10.07.2019 and 02.08.2019, the petitioner submitted himself before the trial Court, who has been released on interim regular bail upon his furnishing the requisite bail bonds and surety bonds.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and petitioner is allowed to remain on the same bail bonds and surety bonds furnished by him before the trial Court on 05.08.2019.
