This petition was filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.507 dated 08.07.2001 under Sections 324, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar, District Jalandhar on the ground that despite preparation of untraced report, the same has not been filed before the Competent Court.

On 15.07.2019, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that after investigation in the impugned FIR, an untraced report was prepared, however, despite approval, the same has not been presented till date.

Mr. Ramdeep Partap Singh, DAG, Punjab is directed to find out the status of investigation in FIR No.507 dated 08.07.2001 registered under Sections 324 and 148 read with Section 149 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sadar, District Jalandhar.

Counsel for the petitioners undertakes to supply three sets of paper book to the learned State counsel, during the course of the day.

Adjourned to 29.07.2019.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Vijay Kumar has apprised the Court that untraced report is ready and is likely to be submitted before the Court of competent jurisdiction within a period of two weeks from today.

In view of the stand of the State, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press this petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.

However, it shall be open for the petitioners to revive the petition in case the untraced report is not filed within the stipulated period.
