Learned counsel for the respondents submits that during the pendency of the writ petition, the benefits as claimed by the petitioner pursuant to his reinstatement have been granted to him, as per his entitlement. He submits that the present writ petition is, therefore, rendered infructuous.

However, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he is unable to respond to the said submission as his attempts to contact his client have been unsuccessful in view of the prevailing situation in the State of Jammu and Kashmir, where he is currently posted.

Be that as it may, in view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the respondents-UOI, the present writ petition is dismissed as infructuous with liberty to move an application, if any cause of action still survives.
