The vendor of the petitioner was allotted Shop-cum-Office (SCO) site No.14 in Sector 12-A, Gurugram, being the highest bidder in a public auction. CWP No. 18199 of 2018 was filed raising a grievance that inspite of allotment made on 12.03.1987, the respondents have not been able to hand over the possession as the land is subject matter of litigation pending in the Supreme Court. The writ petition was disposed of on 25.07.2018 directing the respondents to take a final decision with regard to allotment of alternative site to the petitioner.

As the needful was not done, the present petition is filed.

Pursuant to order dated 19.09.2019, Mr. A.K. Singh, Principal

Secretary to Government of Haryana, Department of Town & Country Planning

is present in Court.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that option of two alternative sites was given to the petitioner and he has to exercise the option.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is grievances with regard to offer made, for which a representation has already been made. Copy of the representation is handed over to Mr. A.K. Singh, Principal Secretary to Government of Haryana, who is present in Court. He submits that in case petitioner appears in his office on 18.12.2019 at 3.00 PM, a reasoned order on the said representation would be passed within a period of two weeks thereafter.

In view of statement made above, the present petition is disposed of.

In case there is a grievance against the order passed, petitioner shall be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law.
