On 15.07.2019, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner has filed affidavit disclosing that the petitioner is not an accused in any other case except FIR No.88. He further contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated due to political rivalry between local leaders.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Rajni Gupta, Sr. DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab and seeks time to get instructions.

Let a copy of the petition be handed over to the learned counsel for the State during course of the day.

Adjourned to 23.08.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2), Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Jagpal Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, interim order dated 15.07.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
