The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.42 dated 13.06.2019 under Sections 295-A, 429 IPC, registered at Police Station Shahpurkandi, District Pathankot.

The operative part of the order dated 15.07.2019, vide which the petitioners have been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as per allegations in the FIR, the petitioners along with four other co-accused have caused death of a cattle. It is further submitted that three co-accused of the petitioners, namely Lal Hussain, Shareef Mohamad and Muskan Ali have already been arrested and as per the FIR, the petitioners ran away from the spot and were not arrested. Learned counsel further submits that recovery of weapon has already been effected from the co-accused and the petitioners are ready to join the investigation.

List again on 01.08.2019.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners,

in pursuance to the order dated 15.07.2019, have already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Narinder Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide order dated 15.07.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
