This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 2 to 7 for initiating appropriate action against respondent Nos. 8 to 11 for sheltering and protecting respondent Nos. 9 to 11 for preparing/ manufacturing false and fabricated record and used the same for their own personal goal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.4 - Deputy Commissioner-cum Director, Food and Supply Department, Chandigarh Administration to consider and decide the representation dated 8.9.2017 (Annexure P-19) expeditiously.

Heard.

A complete set of paper book has been handed over to Ms.Ashima Mor, APP for UT, Chandigarh, in the Court today.

In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the

case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 - Deputy Commissioner-cum Director, Food and Supply Department, Chandigarh Administration to consider and decide the representation dated 8.9.2017 (Annexure P-19) in accordance with law within six weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
