The petitioners filed the writ petition seeking direction to the respondents to complete the backlog of promotion quota in respect of category (iii) and to promote them to the post of Junior Engineer (Electrical) from the admissible date along with all consequential benefits.

The petition was allowed on 30.8.2018. The respondents therein were directed to promote the petitioners on the post of Junior Engineer (Electrical) from the date of their due promotion along with all other consequential benefits.

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading that needful has not been done by the respondent.

In pursuance to notice of motion, reply dated 30.9.2019 was

filed annexing order of promotion dated 27.9.2019.

Learned counsel for the respondent states that petitioners- Sh. Hardev Singh, Technician Grade-2 and Sh. Kulwinder Singh, Technician Grade-2 have been promoted from 1.5.2016 and 1.12.2017 respectively. He has produced copy of pay bill whereby payment of consequential benefits have been made to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that dates of promotion have wrongly been fixed by the respondent.

The said aspect cannot be gone into in the present contempt petition, the grievance made gives rise to fresh cause of action.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty to the petitioners to avail remedies available in accordance with law against order dated 27.9.2019 and also in case there is grievance with regard to calculation of amount.
