The allegation against the petitioner is that she had started harassing and blackmailing the deceased after they had developed illicit relations but subsequently she had started developing relations with somebody else. On query learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Hardeep Singh, submits and reads out from the police file the suicide note left behind by the deceased Raman Thakur, on 30.05.2019, in which it is essentially stated that he was committing suicide on account of the petitioner having developed relations subsequently with somebody else and there being certain footage of physical relations between him and the petitioner, which as per the suicide note read out to this Court, was with the deceased.

In the first suicide note dated 28.05.2019, it is also stated that the deceaseds' wife would not be able to accept the relationship between the deceased and the petitioner.

Consequently, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case for or against the petitioner, but on the basis of the material that has been submitted to this Court in the context of the petitioner seeking anticipatory bail, I deem it appropriate to admit her to such bail.

On the petitioner joining investigation, in case she is sought to be arrested, she would be released on bail, on her furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/Illaqa Magistrate. She shall abide by all the conditions as envisaged in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

If the arresting officer does not join the petitioner in investigation, she would appear before the learned Illaqa Magistrate immediately, who would then summon the arresting officer and direct him to join her in investigation.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
