The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 24.4.2019 passed by this Court in CRM-M-18186 of 2019. The operative part of the order is reproduced below:

“Record perused. The instant petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2-the Superintendent of Police, Nuh to look into the matter and submit the status report to the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate within a period of 45 days, who will monitor the investigation in accordance with the guidelines laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Lalita Kumari v. Government of U. P. and others, 2013 (4) RCR (Criminal) 979.**”

As per the order quoted above, the respondents had to look into the matter and submit the status report to the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate within a period of 45 days.

There is nothing on record to show that certified copy of the order has been supplied to the respondent. Let atleast now certified copy be supplied to the respondent and in case of doing the needful, the respondent shall ensure compliance of the order dated 24.4.2019 within 45 days from the receipt of certified copy of this order. In case of non-compliance, costs may be imposed which shall be recoverable from the defaulting official.

With the aforesaid observation, the contempt petition stands disposed of.
