Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr. P.C.') for grant of bail pending trial to the petitioner, in FIR No.264 dated 09.06.2019, under Section 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 3 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, registered at Police Station Sampla, Rohtak.

Mr. Subhash Godara, Advocate appears, files his Power of Attorney on behalf of the complainant and the same is taken on record.

As per prosecution case, the petitioner abused the complainant's sister as well as by addressing him with caste words and also threatened to shot dead.

Contends that the petitioner is in custody since 09.06.2019 and the matter has been compromised between the parties.

The above factual position is duly acknowledged by learned

State counsel, on instructions from SI Satish as well as counsel for the complainant.

Heard both sides and perused the paper-book.

Since the petitioner is in custody since 09.06.2019 and now the matter is stated to be compromised between the parties, therefore, further incarceration of the petitioner would not serve any purpose.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, in this case, on his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The above observations may not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case as well as compromise, if any, effected between the parties.

The petitioner shall fully co-operate with learned trial Court without seeking any unnecessary adjournments.
