Challenge is to the order passed by the learned trial Court summoning the petitioner, who claims to be the alleged Personal Assistant of a Member of Legislative Assembly, under Section 319 Cr.P.C..

A Food Safety Team with a view to collect samples visited a Bakery and collected food samples. Petitioner whose name was not known to the officials, came there and obstructed Food Safety Team from taking away the samples on the ground that he is Personal Assistant to Local MLA. However, since Food Safety Team did not come under pressure, petitioner ran away with the samples collected by the Food Safety Team. A Member of the Food Safety Team namely Dr. Lakhbir Singh when appeared in evidence has stated that he came to know about the name of the petitioner later on .

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, there is no error in the order passed by the learned trial Court summoning the petitioner under Section 319 Cr.P.C. to face the trial.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
