The instant writ petition has been filed for quashing of the order dated 26.08.2013 (Annexure P-16), whereby the petitioner had been placed under suspension.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in fact, the arrears towards difference on amount due and subsistence allowance paid during suspension period which were calculated as ₹12,67,278/- have already been released to the petitioner. Apart from it, the dues towards his pensionary benefits of ₹1,54,978/- towards leave encashment and ₹10,69,904/- towards GPF have also been paid to the petitioner. Further, the suspension period of the petitioner was also considered as duty period and the case of the petitioner for fixation of pension and gratuity has been sent to the Accountant General, Punjab on 08.12.2018 and as and when sanction would be received, the same will be credited in the bank account of

the petitioner.

In view of the above, as the relief prayed for by the petitioner has been granted, the instant writ petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
