ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.20, dated 16.01.2019, under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 324 and 307 IPC, registered at Police Station Rewari City, District Rewari.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had earlier been granted regular bail but after addition of Section 307 IPC, he was re-arrested and is in custody since 23.03.2019. He also contends that the petitioner is not involved in any other case and the injured has fully recovered from the injuries. He further contends that the petitioner did not misuse the concession of bail which had been granted to him earlier. He also states that the similarly situated co-accused Premjeet @ Pintu has been granted regular bail by this Court in CRM-M-24578-2019 on 31.05.2019.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Vinod Kumar states that 2 out of 15 prosecution witnesses have been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when he is in custody for over 7 months, the co-accused having been granted bail and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
