Vide order dated 24.05.2019 compromise was effected between the parties in the terms that the matter would stand settled upon payment of a consolidated amount of ₹1,75,000/- by respondent No.2 – Management to the petitioner and with the said payment, all the disputes between the parties would stand finally settled. Statement of the parties was recorded separately to this effect and the case was adjourned for today for payment.

Today, learned counsel and representative of respondent No.2 – Management have handed over a cheque bearing No.212417 dated 27.05.2019 for a sum of ₹1,75,000/- (₹ One Lakh Seventy Five Thousand Only) as full and final settlement of all the claims of the petitioner including the statutory claims like gratuity etc., as per compromise statement recorded on 24.05.2019 in this Court. Their statement to this effect has also been recorded separately today.

Statement of the petitioner has also been recorded separately today to the effect that he has received the above stated cheque as full and final settlement of all his claims including the statutory claims like gratuity etc. from respondent No.2, as per compromise statement recorded on

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as withdrawn.

Accordingly, in view of the statement of the parties recorded separately today, the writ petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
