Petitioner has impugned the order dated 21.06.2017 (Annexure P-9), whereby adjustment of the petitioner by way of transfer on the post of Senior Assistant in the office of respondent No.2 has been withdrawn/cancelled. According to him, same is arbitrary and without affording any opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

Learned State counsel submits that petitioner was initially appointed as clerk on compassionate grounds in the year 1999 in the Transport Department, Punjab. He was promoted as Senior Assistant in the same department in November, 2011. Petitioner on his own submitted representation dated 18.8.2016 for his adjustment in the office of State Transport Commissioner. Vide order dated 10.10.2016, this request was accepted and petitioner was posted in the said office. However, later it was found that the order accommodating the petitioner in the office of State Transport Commissioner was not as per norms. Order was, thus,

withdrawn and petitioner was reverted to the State Transport Department without any loss, financial or otherwise. He even joined back pursuant to said order, in July, 2017 and is working as such.

This court does not find any ground to interfere in the writ jurisdiction. It is settled position that in case of a bonafide error in an administrative order, same can always be corrected by the administrative authority.

Dismissed.
