Challenge in this writ petition is to the Award passed by the Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court, Ambala dated 05.12.2013 (Annexure P-5), whereby respondent No. 1-workman has been reinstated in service with 50% back wages from the date of termination till the date of reinstatement.

On the last date of hearing, this Court had observed that in case the back wages are given up by the workman-respondent No. 1, as ordered by the Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court, the petitioners would not press the writ petition challenging the Award.

Learned counsel for respondent No. 1, on instructions from respondent No. 1-Ishma son of Sh. Ramji Lal, who is present in Court, states that he would give up the claim of back wages as awarded by the

Labour Court in the light of the fact that he has been reinstated in service with all consequential benefits.

Counsel for the petitioners, on instructions from Sh. Alok Sheokand, Clerk, D.F.O. Kaithal, has acknowledged the factum of the reinstatement of respondent No. 1.

In the light of the above, the Award passed by the Labour Court is modified to the extent that respondent No. 1 be reinstated in service with all consequential benefits without back wages.

The writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
