On the oral request made by learned counsel, a correction in the memo of parties is permitted. Respondent No.3 would now read as Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa instead of Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur.

Registry is directed to carry out necessary changes in the memo of parties.

Petitioner raises a grievance that he is being prevented from running lottery business from his shop/stall within the municipal limits of Sardulgarh, District Mansa inspite of having necessary permission/ authority/ licence under the provisions of Lotteries (Regulations) Act, 1998, Lotteries (Regulation) Rules, 2010 and Punjab State Regulation Rules, 2015.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner at length, instant petition is disposed of in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to agitate his grievance before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa-respondent No.3 along with all

supporting/ relevant documents in support of his contention that he is duly authorized and he is a licence holder to run the lottery business.

In the eventuality of any such representation being filed before respondent No.3 along with the requisite/supporting documents, respondent No.3 would be obligated to examine the same and thereafter to take necessary steps as he may deem fit in accordance with law.
