HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J.

Learned counsel for the petitioner very fairly states that though the petitioner had a certificate titled "*Army certificate of Education*" in the first class issued to him on 07.11.1981, but he failed to deposit a copy of the same with the respondents. Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the said certificate is equivalent to 10th standard, which is clear from the letter of the Director, Sainik Welfare Punjab dated 15.12.2006 (Annexure P/6) and, therefore, the petitioner fulfilled all the requisite qualification prescribed to be promoted from class IV to Class III post under the rules governing the service.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that let the petitioner file representation alongwith the copy of the relevant certificate before the competent authority and the competent authority, keeping in view the relevant provisions of service, coupled with the report of Director, Sainik Welfare Punjab dated 15.12.2006 (Annexure P/6) will pass an appropriate order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of said representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that keeping in view the

statement made by the learned counsel for the respondents, he will file the representation with the respondents and does not wish to press the present writ petition any further and the same may be disposed off as such.

In view of the above, the present writ petition stands dismissed as having been not pressed.
