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KRISHNA MURARI, CHIEF JUSTICE: (Oral)

The issue is in respect of the action taken by the Executive Officer, Nagar Council, Naya Gaon, District Mohali, in response to the direction issued regarding adoption of the Building Bye-Laws 1997 and implementation thereof in response to the legal notice issued by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that despite letter dated 05.10.2018 issued by the Directorate, Local Government, Punjab to the Executive Officer, Nagar Council, Naya Goan, no further action has been taken.

Ms. Monica Chibber Sharma, learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab at the outset states that in case the letter dated 05.10.2018 has not been responded to till date by the Executive Officer, Nagar Council, Naya Gaon and the Building Bye Laws, 1997, have not been adopted, a suitable action in accordance with law shall be taken against the Executive Officer and the dispute with respect to adoption of the Building Bye-Laws by the Executive Officer shall be brought to its logical end within a period of four weeks from today.

In the wake of the assurance given by the learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, we do not find any reason to continue this petition on board any further and the same stands disposed of in the light of the statement made before us.
