Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0057 dated 24.12.2018 under Sections 341, 354-D IPC and Section 12 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, registered at Police Station Arif Ke, Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated July 11, 2019 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jagtar Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his

custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated July 11, 2019 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
