The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.144 dated 24.05.2019, under Sections 379-A, 384 and 389 of the IPC, registered at Police Station City Narwana, District Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that she along with the co-accused had stolen the car of the complainant. He further contends that the car has been recovered. The petitioner is in custody since 26.05.2019. She is 30 years old lady with two minor children and is not involved in any other case.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is 30 years old lady, car has been recovered, she is not involved in any other case and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on her furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
