1. The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.975, dated 18.12.2017, registered at Police Station City, Sirsa, under Sections 323, 34, 498-A, 506 IPC and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties and the marriage between the parties also stands dissolved.
2. Vide order dated 22.7.2019 the parties had been directed to appear before the Trial Court so as to get their statements recorded.

3. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Sirsa, has been received wherein it has been reported that statement of complainant Nisha Insan and her mother Santosh as well as of petitioners/accused Nirmal Goyal and Rajiv Goyal (through his special power of attorney Smt. Nirmal Goyal), have been recorded to the effect that they have entered into a compromise with the intervention of respectables. The complainant and her mother have specifically stated that the matter has been compromised with the petitioners and they do not want to pursue with the matter. Learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Sirsa, opined that the compromise effected between the parties is genuine.
4. In view of the aforesaid report and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.975, dated 18.12.2017, registered at Police Station City, Sirsa, under Sections 323, 34, 498-A, 506 IPC, and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
