Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.38 dated 02.06.2019 registered under Sections 323, 498-A, 34 of IPC at Police Station Sekhwan, District Gurdaspur.

Vide order dated 12.07.2019, while issuing notice of motion in the case, the petitioners were granted ad-interim bail, however, subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and to abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C.

No one is present on behalf of the petitioners.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Surjit Singh, states that pursuant to the order dated 12.07.2019, petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is no more required at this stage.

Heard.

Since the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 12.07.2019 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
