Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been arraigned as an accused in the FIR only on the statement of a co-accused and therefore, he having remained in custody for almost 06 months now, with the trial still at its initial stage, he may be granted the concession of bail.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Head Constable Anil Kumar, submits that as a matter of fact the petitioner has been identified as one of the assailants by the complainant, in the Test Identification Parade (TIP) held by the police.

Having considered the matter, though identification in the TIP is obviously something to be considered seriously, yet with the petitioner having already undergone about 06 months of actual custody, as per the custody certificate filed in Court today by learned State counsel, with no other criminal case shown to be registered against him and he being shown to be a young man of

23 years, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
