Prayer in the present petition is to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.38 dated 07.06.2019 registered under Section 380 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Fatehgarh Churian, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

On 12.07.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner and complainant/alleged victim are husband and wife. He further contends that as per allegations made in the FIR, petitioner had stolen gold jewellery and some cash from the house.

On the other hand, Mr. A.K.Walia, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of the husband/alleged victim and submits that the parties are residing separately for the last

8½ months and apart from gold jewellery weighing about 23 tollas, cash amount of Rs.5,50,000/- has also been stolen.

Keeping in view the contentions raised by learned counsel for the parties, this Court is prima-facie of the opinion that the Investigating Agency should be called upon to give status of the investigation.

Notice of motion for 22.08.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Varinder Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation.

Keeping in view the facts of the present case as noticed in the order dated 12.07.2019, interim protection granted on 12.07.2019 is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
