The application is allowed as prayed for. Head Master, Government Elementary School, Aasal, District Ferozeur is allowed to be impleaded as Respondent No.6. Amended memo of parties is taken on record.

Main case

This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus for directing respondent Nos. 2 to 5 to decide the representation dated 14.09.2014 (Annexure P-3).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.6-

Head Master, Government Elementary School, Aasal, District Ferozeur

to consider and decide the representation dated 14.09.2014 (Annexure P-3) or any other representation to be filed by the petitioner.

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.6-Head Master, Government Elementary School, Aasal, District Ferozeur to consider and decide the representation dated 14.09.2014 (Annexure P-3) or any other representation to be filed by the petitioner, within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
