Petitioner seeks a mandamus for directing the official respondents to protect her life and liberty by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 6.

During the courser of arguments it stands conceded that petitioner had earlier approached this Court by filing CWP No. 16704 of 2019 raising similar prayer.

Such petition was dismissed as withdrawn on 13.06.2019, so as to avail appropriate remedies in accordance with law.

The instant petition does not bring forth any concrete material to show any imminent danger and threat to the life of the petitioner on account of any event/circumstance that may have occurred after disposal of the previous petition on 13.06.2019.

Under such circumstances, no intervention is called for.

Petition dismissed.
