This application has been filed on behalf of the applicant-appellant for disposal of the main appeal bearing RSA No.3091 of 2006 in view of the settlement/compromise dated 06.05.2019 reached between the parties before the Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

It appears from the record that the main appeal was admitted by this Court on 28.07.2009 and on an application filed on behalf of the respondents and supported by the applicant-appellant, the matter was referred to the Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court vide order of this Court dated 19.03.2019.

The report of the Mediator has been placed on record to the effect that the parties have settled their dispute by way of amicable settlement and a copy of that duly signed by all the parties is available on record.

Both the parties are represented by their respective counsel.

On perusal of the settlement/compromise reached between the parties before the Mediator in the Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court, this Court is of the opinion that the same is lawful.

Accordingly, this application is allowed and since the main case is admitted by this Court vide order dated 28.07.2009, the same is being heard and taken on regular board today itself.

In view of the above, this appeal stands disposed of in terms of the settlement/compromise dated 06.05.2019 reached between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and that would form part of the decree.
