JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J.

This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent for leasing out the Canteen at New Judicial Courts Complex, S.A.S., Nagar, Mohali to the petitioner being the highest bidder.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that a committee was constituted to conduct the open auction for leasing out the Canteen at New Judicial Courts Complex, S.A.S., Nagar, Mohali for the period of 01.04.2018 to 31.03.2019 in which the petitioner made the highest bid of Rs.4,02,000/- but the committee recommended cancellation of tender process for the canteen and the same is still not functional.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the respondent states that the period of one year has already expired on 31.03.2019 and the present petition has become infructuous.

In view of the above and considering the fact that the lease period in question has already expired on 31.03.2019 and cancellation of the bid by the Committee is not actuated by any *malafide*, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
