RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J. (ORAL):

The petitioner purchased a vehicle at a bank auction. There were dues to be paid on the vehicle with the Regional Transport Authority, Karnal-respondent No.3. Respondent No.4 and 5-Bank has discharged the outstanding dues towards taxes and other government charges.

The petitioner has approached this Court for a direction to respondents No.4 and 5-Bank to pay the dues of the vehicle to the Government and thereafter the Transport Department to issue a 'No Objection Certificate' to help in transfer of the vehicle in his name. The Bank has discharged its duty and has stepped out of the case. The obligation of the Regional Transport Authority-respondent No.3 remains to be discharged as there are no longer any impediments of charges against the vehicle.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3

to provide a 'No Objection Certificate' to the petitioner within a period of 14 days from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this Court. The vehicle will comply with the present standards under the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988. In case there are any such impediments to overcome, then the period of compliance shall be extended by another 14 days.

The petition stands allowed as above.
