Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during pendency of the writ petition, the daughter of the petitioner (widow) has become a major. Daughter is entitled to seek appointment on compassionate grounds owing to death of her father who died in harness.

In view thereof, the petitioner does not wish to pursue her case for compassionate appointment and also keeping in view that as per the medical report, the petitioner has been diagnosed with a 'Defective Distant Vision' owing to which she may not be suitable for appointment as Peon/Tradesmen/Follower.

The present writ petition is, therefore, disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-The Assistant Commandant, (North

Zone), CISF, North Zone Headquarters, Saket, New Delhi to pass a speaking order on the representation of the daughter of the petitioner, which the learned counsel for the petitioner states, that petitioner's daughter would be filing within a period of four weeks.

Let the needful be done within a period of two months from the date of its filing as stated by learned counsel for the petitioner The above order is being passed without prejudice to the rights of the petitioner.

Writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
