AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the State has brought to the notice of this Court that Harpal Kaur and four others have filed Civil Writ Petition No.9137 of 2019 (Harpal Kaur and others Vs. Financial Commissioner and others), challenging the order passed by the Financial Commissioner, Punjab, dated 18.01.2016 (Annexure P-1), in which, while issuing notice of motion by this Court on 06.05.2019, status-quo with regard to possession, as it existed on the said date, has been ordered to be maintained. He, thus, contends that the present writ petition cannot survive in the light of the status-quo order passed by this Court.

I have perused the case file of Civil Writ Petition No.9137 of 2019 and find the assertions made by counsel for the State to be correct.

In view of the above, the present writ petition, as of now, cannot be further proceeded with. The writ petition, therefore, stands disposed of in terms of the fact that there is an interim order maintaining status-quo. The outcome of Civil Writ Petition No.9137 of 2019 will govern the fate of ultimate execution of the partition.
