After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file a fresh one on the same cause of action by challenging the notification dated 16.01.2009 appended as Annexure R-2 with the reply filed by the respondents, according to which, the benefit to the family of the missing Government employee is only to be given after a period of seven years of the registration of an FIR, which according to the petitioner is contrary to the 2006 Rules, wherein the benefit is to be granted to the missing person as well and therefore, family of the missing person will be entitled for the

benefits immediately when the said employee went missing.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty, as prayed for.
