The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.89 dated 27.04.2019, under Sections 323, 341, 506, 148 & 149 IPC (Section 307 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Samrala, District, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the injury, which is attributed to the petitioner, is on the shoulder of the complainant who has fully recovered therefrom. The injury, for which Section 307 IPC has been invoked, is attributed to the co-accused Gurdeep Singh @ Deepa.

This Court, by the order dated 12.07.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating/Arresting Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Jaswinder Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation and not required for custodial interrogation, the order dated 12.07.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
