On 15.07.2019, following order was passed:-

“The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that all the injuries allegedly sustained by the complainant are simple in nature.

Notice of motion for 26.11.2019.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Suresh Kumar, has submitted that the petitioner in this case has joined the investigation, cooperated and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, interim order dated 15.07.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
